

ANNUAL REPORT 2017-18

The School reopened a bit late this academic year on June 12, 2018 due to the Nipa Virus Threat that affected our district. Yet Ideal Public School kept up its torch burning at the best in the opening month of June, brimming with activities.

JUNE, 2018

Environment week was observed in the School on 14th June with special assemblies, Tree plantation drive and rally. International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21st June with a Mass Yoga and display demonstrated by a renowned Yogacharya Afzal Saheer Gurukul . Our class 5th student Arya Nanda participated in the Zee Tamil reality show in Chennai and secured one kilo gold as runner up. Our School secured 100 percent results in class X board exams with 19 distinctions out of 29 students, 7 first class. Our student toppers scored 100 percent marks in Social Science in class X. In class 12 we secured 2 distinctions and 13 first class holders with Ashwin. S achieving distinction marks and was awarded the district topper award in the CBSE Award function held at MADIN SCHOOL MALAPPURAM.

CBSE regional office appointed the principal of Ideal Public School as the city coordinator of Malappuram which is another milestone in the growth of our School. The reading week started from 18th June and World Reading day was observed. Students commemorated the death anniversary of Vaikom Muhammed Basheer by participating in reading activities conducted by the library. Salma Mehr won the first in the competition. On 11th World Population Day was observed with a poster making competition , Road safety day on 13th with an activity in Kindergarten , and National Junk Food Day was also observed on 21st July.

JULY, 2018

Our School worked as the centre for the **NET UGC** Examination on 8th July and won great appreciation from the CBSE for the excellent coordination of the exam. World Population Day was observed by Kindergarten on 13th 2018. The School Investiture ceremony was conducted on 13th in a special assembly and office bearers for the Students council were sworn in. Our teachers attended the CBSE workshop held in Islahiya School Malappuram on 20th and 21st and two teachers attended the same from the primary and secondary level. Our School won laurels in the Junior girls amateur Taekwondo championship clinching the third position in the district for Junior boys and Senior girls. A friendly football match was conducted between teachers and students on 18th morning. Class PT Meetings were conducted from 1st to 3rd for classes LKG 1&2. Issues were addressed On July 15th our boys and girls secured overall first in Malappuram District Taekwondo subjunior championship.

On 11th World Population Day was observed with a poster making competition , Road safety day on 13th with an activity in Kindergarten , and National Junk Food Day was also observed on 21st July with an awareness program in Kindergarten. AUGUST, 2018

PTA Executive committee meeting last meeting was held on 18th Wednesday and General Body was held on 4th August, 2018. Hiroshima Day was observed on 6th with a poster making .The annual cultural fest TALENTIA 2018 was conducted on 9th and 10th. Nagasaki day was also observed on 9th with a special assembly. Independence Day was celebrated with great pomp and splendor. School closed for Onam holidays on 13th after a colorful Onam celebration and on 16th due to floods schools were declared closed up to 29th. Special online classes through WhatsApp were held from 17th to 28th for classes 10 & 12. On August 10th – 13th we participated in the state championship held at Ernakulum and won two bronze medals.

SEPTEMBER , 2018

Under the initiative of the PTA a new temporary swimming pool was inaugurated on 1st September. Around 150 students were thoroughly trained in swimming for more than two weeks. Labor Day was celebrated on 3rd September and the housekeeping staff of our School were honored for their services by the children. On 5th September teacher's day was observed with a special assembly and discussion on challenges faced by teachers. PTA Executive was formed on 13th and decided to cut short all celebrations this year due to the flood disaster. A cake was presented by the Ratnasagar publications wishing all teachers. Student teachers took the roles of teachers and were awarded prizes for their performance. On September 14 a 'miss a meal' program was initiated by students in which they observed fasting and donated money to the collectors flood relief fund. Hon. Collector Meena appreciated our students. A few teachers were sent for ICT training workshop held at Calicut. Kindergarten students observed Grandparent's Day and children made cards for their grandparents. On 29th September a cleanliness week was announced up to 2nd October in connection with Gandhi Jayanthi. SWACCHATHA HI SEVA activities were conducted by our green patrols and students cleaned the surrounding areas of the School and disposed almost 8 sacks of plastic waste with the help of the Resident Association. A special assembly was also observed for the surgical strike and oath taken in honor of the country and Indian Army. Students delivered speeches on what they feel about the brave soldiers and their services to the country.

OCTOBER, 2018

On Gandhi Jayanthi the School conducted a Debate Competition for higher classes on the topic 'cleanliness is more important than freedom'. On 22nd October the fund collected through Miss a Meal program was handed over to the district collector Amit Meena. On 25th October the EXCISE DEPARTMENT performed a wonderful skit on drug abuse in the School Auditorium and conducted a very informative class for students against drugs .A seminar was conducted by class 6-8 on cleanliness. Kiddies Sports was organized on 24th and Annual Sports day on 26th October. The famous arm wrestler V.P. VINOD an International champion graced the occasion and inspired students speaking to them about how despite his handicap of polio stricken limbs he could achieve great glory in sports . He also motivated the champions by his words "If a handicapped man like me can hold the championship trophy

it's simply easy for healthy children like you." A colorful display by students added splendor to the Sports Day.

NOVEMBER, 2018

Kerala Piravi celebrations by the department of Malayalam instilled in all students the love for their motherland and mothertongue. A special assembly with variety of programmes like group song , recitation , dance etc added splendor to the day. A get together with PTA Executives was organized on the same day. Arya Nanda our little nightingale won a kilo of gold as runner up in the zee reality show and brought glory to us. On 14th November ,Children's day was observed and an interschool Quiz contest **BIG BUZZ QUIZ** was organized in the School. 8 schools from the Tirur region participated in the Quiz and we won the third. The Kindergarten observed grandparents Day and students made greeting cards for their grandparents. They also honored the house keeping staff and thanked them for their services.

On 15th November our KHO-KHO students participated in the Kozhikode district championship and secured overall third. Haya Fathima represented the Kozhikode district and participated in the state level. Students participated in the Subjunior state Taekwondo championship in Kasargod and we won a gold and three bronze medals. Sree Sankar won selection to the national levels in Telangana.

A BOOK FAIR by DC Books was organized on 23rd and 24th in the School campus and DROP EVERYTHING AND READ activity was also observed to encourage reading habits.

DECEMBER, 2018

AIDS day was observed in the school with a special assembly on 1st December, 2018. Students delivered speeches to create awareness about the need to unite against the deadly pandemic that took the lives of over 35 million people all over the world since the 1980s. Students displayed posters of AIDS awareness, wore the red ribbon and performed a thematic tableau that throws light on the social stigma created by AIDS. The Parent Eye trainer Mr. Shaji conducted a workshop for all teachers from 10.00 to 1.00 a.m.

On December 3rd,2018 a house wise bulletin board competition was organized and topics related to Xmas were given to the four houses. Students laid out colorful display of topics like legend of Xmas, Santa Claus, stories of Xmas and Xmas carol. Every month students are given topics to display as part of house activities in order to enable them to have a thorough knowledge about current affairs and the world around them.

On December 6th, 2018 Our Kho Kho team participated in the district competition held in Islahiya senior secondary school Edpal. Our team of girls U – 17 won the first runners up trophy. Haya Fathima and Pooja Suresh won individual trophies for best performance. Haya Fathima also won the best player of the tournament trophy. On December 7th ,2018 Our Students participated in the Sub Junior State Taekwondo championship held at Kasargod. Thirteen students had participated in the meet out of which

we won three Bronze medals and one gold. Sree Shanker who won the gold medal has been qualified for the national level taekwondo meet to be held at Sikkim.

On December 10th, 11th 2018 around 58 students participated in the Central Sahodaya Athletic meet held at Calicut University stadium. We won 32 medals that comprised of 8 Gold, 12 Silver and 12 Bronze. The overall third position trophy in the meet was begged by us with a total score of 100 points. We also got the 3rd overall trophies in the under 12 girls, under 16 boys, under 19 girls and first overall in the under 16 girls category.

On December 12, 2018 our students had participated in the Inter school English fest held at Kamb & M School, Edapal. We won the first place in the calligraphy competition and many prizes for book review cat 3, 4, pair anchoring Cat 4, live reporting Cat 4, interview cat 4 & Choral recitation Cat 2.

On December 20, 2018 the Kindergarten celebrated Xmas on 20th December with great pomp and splendor. Children adorned themselves in red costumes and arranged class parties with a wide variety of sweets, cakes and homemade delicacies. Students made greeting cards for Xmas. The teachers decorated the classrooms, sang Carol songs for the tiny tots and spread the message of sharing, loving and caring.

On December, 22, 2018 the school closed for winter vacations in a festive mood despite the second periodic tests and students held class parties. The best decoration and arrangement was awarded a prize and also for the best bulletin board display for Christmas. Students donated money for the cause of charity which would be handed over as Xmas gift to a child affected with kidney failure.

The Kindergarten had a number of fun filled activities with color days observed every month, the animal day, the water day etc; which enabled students to learn the play way.

In spite of the loss of working days due to the floods, the School performed at its best in all spheres and kept up its team spirit. Our teachers attended various CBSE workshops this year and we could bridge the gap created by the floods by using online teaching in the holidays. Regular meetings with parents help us to solve issues amicably and the Management has always turned a benevolent eye towards all our ventures. The support of PTA has been a motivating factor and the excellent team work and commitment to the vision and mission of our School help us move on confidently towards the New year that brings more promises.
