

Annual School Report- 2019

A very warm good evening and welcome to one and all

It is indeed a moment of great pride and honor for me to address this august gathering on the auspicious occasion of our 22nd Annual day celebration.

Distinguished chief guest of this festive occasion, dignitaries on and off the dias, parents, teachers and my dear children.

The school has made remarkable achievements in the field of education, with more than 861 students and 68 members of staff on the rolls.

This academic year geared up well for the classes UKG to XII on 1st June 2019 and this year our 10th Std results put us on the top of the pyramid with 100 percent distinction. Admissions have been flowing in this year showing a steady growth.

Our teachers attended Inservice training workshops in all subjects in May to gear themselves up well for the new academic year from 1st June, 2019. LKG classes commenced on 7th June with a colorful ice breaking day for kids and orientation for parents, hence we had an opening free of tears. A full fledged FM Radio Studio is the highlight of our achievement this year & we are grateful to the support of our PTA who helped us to make this dream come true. RJ Subu of Red FM trained our students & Mr. Mohammed Kutty PTA President, soft launched the Hi FM of our school. The Kindergarten section was renovated with cupboards ,pin boards and playarea roofed up with flowering creepers .

On 6th June the World Environment Day was observed with a special assembly, Tree plantation drive, green rally and poster making competition was conducted. Yoga Day was observed on 21st June with a wonderful mass display, speech and the world music day was also observed on the same day. We have students as green patrols to save electricity and water, instilling in them a sense of responsibility towards nature. The KG students celebrated the green day on the 20th of June through a variety of hand activities like colouring, feather/ flower pasting ,speech and nature walk. On the Vegetable day, these students spoke and sung about their favourite vegetable and ate salad .World reading day was celebrated with a special assembly by the Malayalam department . Reading week was conducted from 17th June to 22nd June by a book exhibition and various competitions like the reading competition, quiz and dear time. The International Anti drug addiction day was observed through a special assembly and poster making competition.

We conducted various Programmes in July observing the Red Day by KG students, The school Investiture ceremony on the same day wherein , the flag bearers of the student council were sworn in, World population day which was observed by a health talk by Dr. Haseena, KG junk

food day and the international day of friendship with special assemblies, skit, speeches and posters . On 16 July a special assembly was conducted focusing on the awareness on Road Safety and a rally holding placards to Anagadi . In order to promote physical development sand activities were conducted for kg students that helped to improve their eye hand co-ordination and small muscle control.

August was welcomed by Kg students with the blue day. The CBSE School inspection and observing the Hiroshima day took place on 6th of August with a special assembly. Our student Salma Mehar won the 1st prize in the district level vayana malsaram quiz competition conducted by Malapuram District library council and 5th position at the state level. This month we celebrated the Flag day, National leaders day and independence day with great zeal and enthusiasm .CCA Fest for KG and classes 1 to 12 was conducted on 26th and 27th of August.

We observed the International Labour Day on 3rd September by honouring our house keeping staffs with a gift by KG, 1 & 2nd STD students. Teachers Day was celebrated on 5th September by a special assembly conducted by students who played the role of teachers in the first period as student teachers. Games were also organized by students to honor their teachers. The PTA honoured our senior most teacher Ms Ryna and also the other teachers on this day. Onam was celebrated on 6th September .Students had to organize sadya and decorate their classes with displays about onam.

On 2nd October, Gandhi Jayanthi was observed with a cleanliness campaign for a whole week. The CBSE district kalotsav was conducted on 10, 11, 12th of October. Around 65 students participated in various competition and were able to make sterling achievements in events like –Oppana, elocution, anchoring, versification essay writing, light music, tabala, classical music ,collage etc. with many first & second prizes. Around 9 students participated in the state kalotsav held at Ernakulam .Arya Nanda won 3rd place for light music. On 14th October the KG students observed the Nature Day.

November was a month of activities including the study tour, kids sports, annual sports meet and the kids fest wherein the kids showcased their talent and won many prizes. Our LP, UP and high school students were a part of the Smart energy programme conducted by KSEB. Children participated in the quiz, cartoon, water colouring competition . The grade 12 students visited the Botanical garden at Pantheerankave as part of their educational visit. Students explored the expansive garden stretching to 45 acres that provided them with the pleasure of experiential learning .The class 12 commerce students went on an educational visit to HiLite business park. The students had a rendezvous with the various department heads on the topics like HR policies, Finance, business strategies, marketing etc.

Ideal public school had the proud privilege of hosting the Sahodaya CBSE district science Fest 'Sastryan-2019' for the first time ever in its campus. The event was conducted on 2nd December, attended by more than thousand students from more than 20 different schools. Mr. Manash Bagchi the curator of Calicut planetarium was the chief guest. Students displayed their

working, and still models in different stages. Mr. Tonish conducted the science quiz and science-related magic show was an added attraction. A show on wild life photography, displays from KSEB on energy conservation and exhibits from planetarium provided good exposure to the students. The press and media encouraged the event with wide coverage. Christmas was celebrated by donating an amount to the palliative care of vallikinnu by teachers and students. many programs related to Christmas were organized.

This year also our students actively participated in different sports competitions and won many medals, certificates and trophies. At the Malappuram district cadet Taekwondo championship 12 students participated and all won medals. 5 students participated In the state Taekwondo championship at Calicut indoor stadium and won medals. In the subjunior and junior district Taekwondo championship 19 students participated wherein our subjunior girls won the overall first position and junior girls won the overall second position

At the Malappuram central Sahodaya athletics meet held at Calicut university, 61 students participated. We bagged the first prize for march past, 15 medals in various events, overall second for junior girls, overall second for senior girls, and 3rd place in the relay under 19 girls. Shahana P. was declared the individual champion.

At the central Sahodaya volleyball tournament we won overall second, the central Sahodaya throwball tournament we won the overall first. Shamna Julfath was the individual champion and at the central kho-kho championship under 14 and under 17 we won overall first position. 6 Students represented our school at the international Taekwondo championship held at Hyderabad in the month of June.
